

INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES AT KHPT

KHPT is a not-for-profit organization which spearheads focused initiatives to improve the health and well-being of communities in India. In 2003, KHPT was founded with a mission to enhance the health and wellbeing of vulnerable communities and our journey started with the focus on reducing the prevalence of HIV in Karnataka, specifically among most at-risk populations. These interventions were evidence-driven, systematically planned, rigorously implemented, and monitored. KHPT has succeeded in scaling impact well beyond Karnataka and has become a learning site for innovative approaches. The unique DNA of our programs is a combination of evidence generation, grassroots community connect, and strong government relationships. KHPT has extended its decades-long experience to work in themes such as Tuberculosis (TB), Maternal, Neonatal and Child Health & Nutrition (MNCH+N), Adolescent Health (AH), and Comprehensive Primary Healthcare (CPHC). KHPT has cross-cutting functional teams such as Communications and Knowledge Management, Monitoring, Evaluation, Research and Learning (MERL) and Digital Transformation.

Internships at KHPT

KHPT invites graduates and postgraduates from public health, social science, social work or management backgrounds, including qualifications in human resources, finance, administration, and related disciplines, to take up internships within its thematic areas and functional areas.

- ◆ The internship period is a minimum of four months depending upon the requirement. The standard workweek is Monday through Friday and normal work hours are 09:00 am to 5:00 pm.
- ◆ The intern should be willing to be located in rural project locations of KHPT. KHPT will provide guidance on relocation for the internship period, if required.
- ◆ The internship is meticulously structured to offer the students a wide-ranging set of tasks to choose and learn from. Specific internship expectations and deliverables are generally developed once students join us.
- ◆ The internship progress is closely monitored and interns are mentored by the KHPT team members working in the areas they have chosen.
- ◆ The internships at KHPT are unpaid and focused more on learning. The interns will be provided an internship completion certificate upon successful completion of the internship period.

Procedure of Selection

Internship applications will be screened and interns will be selected through interviews, based on their merits and knowledge of the subject areas mentioned above.
